Student Dress Code

As a Catholic School, we want to help our students understand that modesty and respect are an essential part of who we are and what we represent. Students are expected to dress in appropriate clothing that is suitable for the weather and represents the values we express in our Catholic faith. In general, students are expected to have a clean appearance that is reasonable, modest, decent and respectable.

In keeping with that philosophy, the following guidelines should be followed in determining the appropriateness of clothing:

- Muscle shirts, open back shirts, and shirts/dresses with spaghetti straps are not appropriate for school.
- All shirts should cover the waistline of pants/shorts, skirts and sweat pants at all times. Bare midriffs are not appropriate for school.
- Short shorts and short skirts are not appropriate for school.
- Sleepwear is not appropriate for school.
- Footwear must be suitable for general indoor use and emergency evacuation situations.
- Household or bedroom slippers, socks or bare feet are not appropriate for school.

Outdoor clothing including caps, hats or bandanas are not to be worn in the hallways or in class unless it is designated as part of a special spirit day.
